A paid and professional opportunity, working as part of the Abianda team, learning about and influencing our work to increase independence and agency for young women & girls affected by criminal exploitation & violence.

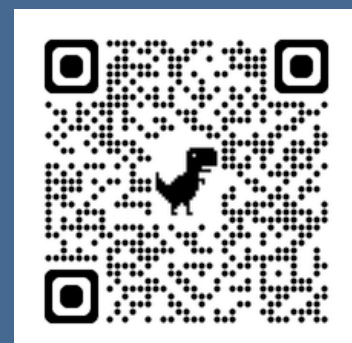

Who is Abianda?

Abianda is a charity that works with young women and girls* affected by criminal exploitation and violence, and provides training for the professionals who work with them. Abianda believes that young women are the experts on their own lives and they should be supported to have their voices heard so that they can influence the design and delivery of services.

*Applies to any individuals who have lived experience that aligns with that of young women and girls

What do I get for joining?

An induction programme to support you with developing skills and confidence, preparing you to be able to do lived experience work in a safe and boundaried way, as well as become a fully embedded member of the Abianda team

Abianda will remunerate lived experience time given to the organisation. This is normally on the basis of £14.35 per hour

The chance to connect with other young women passionate about influencing how Abianda and other organisations serve young women and girls

Learn how you can make your voice heard where it matters most within Abianda and the wider community

Close collaboration with the whole Abianda team, tailoring opportunities to suit the interests of the young women they support
